# REGULAR RED

## 11| Blackberet Pinot Noir 2013

Pays d'Oc, France

\$13.99

Medium depth of colour with juicy, red forest fruit flavours of strawberry and raspberry and a hint of pepper. The small proportion of oaked wine in the blend adds complexity.



## 12| L'Astore Masseria Jema Primitivo 2012

Salento, Italy

\$16.99

The name of the wine recalls the deep historical traditions of this area of Puglia near the heel of Italy. Recently, the company switched to organic agriculture and now has certified organically grown grapes. This robust wine should be paired with meaty dishes either grilled or braised.



## 13| Sarrail Vignobles Cabernet Franc 2013

Languedoc-Roussillon, France

\$12.99

Smooth and sensuous, they coat the tongue with blackberry and black currant flavors, subtle herbal notes and well-integrated acids. Hints of cocoa and earth round out the aromas and flavors with a medium plus finish.



## 14| Etikè Sangivose 'LOVE' 2013

Toscana, Italy

\$19.99

This is dense and packed with black cherry, licorice and peppery spice notes, well-integrated with the solid structure. Hand-craft ceramic label is a plus, and perfect for Valentine's Day.




## 15| Pro Player 2 Jet Toro Opeq Merlot 2009

Lake County, CA

\$19.99

Complex and just-so-right flavors, pipe tobacco, Bing cherry, dried rose petals with a blend of subtle herbs and spice. Great wine for BBQ, tailgate, or picnic.



## 16| Durigutti Bonarda 2012

Mendoza, Argentina

\$14.99

Lush and spicy ripe-fruit driven nose, with a broad, fairly explosive palate of red cherry, plum, chocolate, and mint. Bright, refreshing acidity holds everything together and makes this an excellent choice with spicy foods.



# REGULAR WHITE



111 Falesco Tellus Chardonnay 2013  
Umbria, Italy

\$16.99

Tellus Chardonnay aims to capture imminent drinkability through stainless steel élevage. Expect a crisp reference to citric fruits such as lemons and orchard fruits such as apples to define the aromas and palate impressions.



121 Domaine Jean Vullien & Fils Jacquere 2014  
Savoie, France

\$14.99

Made from 100% Jacquere, an indigenous variety, the wine is fine and ethereal, but also has a laser-like focus clear as a crisp mountain stream. It is perfect on its own as an aperitif, and also with mild cheeses, white fish and lettuce salads.



131 Limestone Hill De Wetshof Chardonnay 2013  
Robertson, South Africa

\$14.99

Heavy clay soils rich in limestone allow this Chardonnay to emit optimum varietal expression in a cloak of rich complexity. An unoaked wine, Limestone Hill has notes of grapefruit and nuts, with the complexity balanced by a nuanced elegance ending with a delicate ripeness.



141 Jorge Ordonez Botani Moscatel 2012  
Alexandria, Spain

\$12.99

Pale straw color. Fresh, fragrant and mature, brimming with the aroma of Muscat grape, apple, mandarin orange and a pinch of wilted flowers. On the palate it is fruity and dry, with notes of citrus and a gentle finish.



151 Lucatoni Pinot Grigio 2015  
Curico Valley, Chile

\$10.99

Intense nose of citrus fruits, pineapple and white flowers. Balanced acidity with distinct nose of lime flavor in the finish.



161 Vinedos y Bodega Pardevalles Albarin Blanco 2013  
Tierra de Leon, Spain

\$17.99

A straw yellow colour wine with green reflections. On the nose there are predominate fruity notes and touches of vegetables, typical of the Albarín grape. In the mouth it is fresh, acidic, fruity, with considerable body and with a tasty and persistent palate.

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# PREMIUM RED

## 111 Château La Roche Beaulieu Aster de Beaulieu 2009 Bordeaux, France

\$34.99

A blockbuster wine for this appellation, with masses of fruit and velvety tannins, toasty oak and chocolate. 75% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon.



## 121 Domaine De La Terre Rouge Tête-à-Tête 2012 Amador County, CA

\$22.99

Sierra Foothills Rhone-Style blend of 40% Mourvèdre 33% Syrah & 27% Grenache. Pretty spices, red and blue fruits, medium bodied, bite of black pepper, lavender, gun flint and Pastis. Makes me think of the Mediterranean and a bowl of wild boar stew.



## 131 Finca Villacreces Pruno 2011 Ribera del Duero, Spain

\$21.99

A spectacular bargain from Villacreces, whose vineyards are situated next to the famous Vega Sicilia, the 2011 Pruno (90% Tempranillo and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon) boasts a dense purple color as well as sweet aromas of licorice, espresso roast, creme de cassis, blackberries, forest floor and spring flowers.



## 141 Chehalem 3 Vineyard Pinot Noir 2011 Willamette Valley, Oregon

\$24.99

Begins with perfect garnet color, as ones nose is immediately met with elegant cherry, black cane fruit, and beautiful floral aromatics. The palate shows low to moderate tannins, silk nap, a nice bitter accent on finish, and age-worthy acid. Warm a sip on the tongue and layers of pie cherry, chocolate, sage, mint, rose petal, juicy summer strawberries, and slight toast.



## 151 Gamble Heritage Red 2011 Napa Valley, CA

\$29.99

Aromas of blueberry pie, blackberry compote and caramel, with a hint of candied bacon and cinnamon. On the palate, ripe blackberry and blackcurrant, cocoa, coffee and smoked bacon seasoned with white pepper.



## 161 Villa Baglio Barolo 2008 Piedmont, Italy

\$22.99

The oak ageing adds to this Barolo strength and warmth, complexity and harmony, great balance besides orange hues and garnet colour. The specific wine-making style make it drinkable without waiting such a long time. Dry, full-body, strong and austere, this Barolo has intense and pleasant bouquet, with scent of faded roses, violet, mushroom and tar.



# PREMIUM WHITE



## 11| Château Teyssier Pezat Blanc 2012

Bordeaux, France

\$19.99

95% Sauvignon Blanc and 5% Semillon. A pale yellow robe, quite intense, the nose is dominated by citrus fruit, white peaches with a hint of white flowers. This wine, typically sauvignon in style, is crisp and fruity on the pallet with a refreshing finish.



## 12| Brokenwood Oakey Creek Semillon 2008

Hunter Valley, Australia

\$34.99

Excellent pale green colour with just a slight tint of yellow. Quite lifted grassy aromas, limes and lemon grass. Low alcohol as is the norm for such years. Light bodied mouth feel. At 10% alcohol there is plenty of natural acidity that carries right to the finish. Excellent drinking now at 6 years or allow more aging over the short term.



## 13| Lis Neris Gris Pinot Grigio 2012

Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy

\$34.99

Fermented in oak barrels, this has aromas that recall white flower, toasted oak, baked pear and dried apricot. The palate offers butterscotch and mature Golden Delicious apple alongside fresh acidity. Toasted hazelnut signals the finish.

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
