[1] FARNESE FANTINI MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO 2014
TUSCANY, ITALY **\$15.99**



Combining impeccable quality and great value, the entry-level Montepulciano is a lush, delightful Abruzzi gem from the classic native variety. Ruby red with garnet reflections; intense, fruity and persistent bouquet with floral and spicy notes confirmed on a full, well balanced palate.

[2] DOMAINE DE ROCHE GUILLON BEAUJOLAIS-VILLAGES 2014
BURGUNDY, FRANCE **\$14.99**



Dry in style, this dark-hued wine comes from vines between 30 and 90 years old. With firm tannins and a dry core, it is only just showing its fruity side. Coming from a five-generation family's vineyard near Fleurie, it has the richness and potential of wines from this cru.

[3] CHATEAU LAVERGNE BORDEAUX ROUGE 2014
BORDEAUX, FRANCE **\$14.99**



Chateau Lavergne made from traditional Bordeaux blend, which includes the three grape varieties - Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. The taste of wine is soft, pleasant, rounded, with hints of cherry, black currant and blackberry, spice notes, peppery nuances and subtle tannins.

[4] THE PATH PINOT NOIR 2013
CALIFORNIA **\$12.99**



Fruit-filled with crushed cherries dominating the nose and cola, wisteria blossom and vanilla playing significant roles. The palate is juicy—wild strawberry, sweetened cranberry, tart cherry and soft caramel combine to make an instant crowd-pleaser. Moderate acidity and vanilla ice cream flavors prevail due to the 10 months of French oak aging.

[5] SCOTTO FAMILY CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2012
LODI, CALIFORNIA **\$13.99**



Lively with very refreshing acidity, especially on the finish which shows lingering after-flavors of tart cranberry and slightly charred wood, supported by tannins. More spice-driven than fruity, more elegant than bold, great clarity and complexity for the price.

[6] DOMAINE LAFAGE NICOLAS GRENACHE 2013
ROUSSILLON, FRANCE **\$15.99**



Another superb value, the 2013 Cuvee Nicolas Vieilles Vignes is 100% Grenache that spent six months in barrel, on lees, prior to being bottle unfiltered. It offers up a forward, mid-weight, sexy feel in its kirsch, dried herbs, earth and spring-flower-driven bouquet.

|1| HUGO GRUNER VELTLINER 2013 TRAISENTAL, AUSTRIA

\$12.99

This refreshing and light-bodied Grüner also has a rounder, riper aspect, referencing flavors of red apple and green pear. While the nose does not give away that much, concentration characterizes the midpalate before an easy, super-clean finish.



|2| CHATEAU PESQUE TERRASSES ROSE 2015 RHONE, FRANCE

\$14.99

Aromas of small fresh red berries and citrus fruits. The mouth offers a great balance and freshness with aromas of gooseberries, raspberries and citrus, with floral notes. Suited to grilled meats and fishes, raw or grilled vegetables, charcuterie, soft white cheese, spicy dishes.



|3| BODEGAS BERROJA BERROIA TXAKOLÍ 2014 MUXIKA, SPAIN

\$16.99

Vibrant mineral-laced citrus pith and green apple aromas show very good clarity and a hint of white flowers. Clean and linear on the palate, offering juicy lemon/lime and honeysuckle flavors and a touch of bitter quince. Finishes spicy and long, leaving a pear skin note behind.



|4| TAMELLINI SOAVE 2015 VENETO, ITALY

\$13.99

With this 100% Garganega wine you will find an elegant nose of sweet field flowers, including chamomile, elder flower, and iris. There are mineral notes on the palate with sweet almond on the finish.



|5| ESPORAO MONTE VELHO 2015 ALENTEJO, SPAIN

\$11.99

Blend of Antão Vaz, Perrum, and Roupeiro. Firm, intense fruity palate, elegant and balanced with a long finish. Adaptable savoury dry Portuguese white that makes a great partner to a wide variety of dishes.



|6| MUSSEL BAY SAUVIGNON BLANC 2015 MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

\$16.99

An intensely pungent gooseberry and asparagus nose, with hints of freshly torn basil leaves. Clean crisp palate with ripe tropical fruits and a well balanced acidity.

[1] FIELD RECORDINGS FRANCO 2015 PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA

Dark and charming, this wine has a huge nose of bramble berry, cedar spice and vanilla. With an inviting medium body comes more bramble fruit and spicy wood notes along with black pepper and baking spice. Shades of sweet cassis berry and alcohol linger around on the finish.

[2] D'ARENBERG D'ARRY'S ORIGINAL 2010 MCLAREN VALE, AUSTRALIA

\$22.99



A terrific value, this 50-50 blend displays gentle oaking and a hint of warm asphalt, just enough to highlight the wine's plum and black cherry fruit. It's full bodied and features a long finish, outlined by wonderfully fine, dusty tannins.

[3] DOMAINE BOUSQUET AMERI 2011 MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

\$36.99



Herbal notes of pine and eucalyptus rest on top of a bedding of spiced cherry and cassis aromas. This Malbec blend is firm and structured, with no weaknesses around the edges or in the middle. Ripe blackberry, spice, mocha and molasses flavors finish toasty but alive.

[4] CASAJUS 2012 RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN

\$24.99



It has a textbook nose of Ribera, with aromas of plums, cherries and strawberries, very typical, with sweet spices from the barrels. An exemplary crianza. The palate is medium to full-bodied, with good weight of fruit, round tannins and flavors that bring back all the notes found in the nose, coming through as a very good Ribera.

[5] CHATEAU DE BREZE CLOS MAZURIQUE ROUGE 2015 LOIRE, FRANCE

\$19.99



Straight out of the gates this Cabernet Franc overflows with perfumes of red and dark cherry, persian mulberry, persimmon, mandarin orange, strongly-scented red and white flowers, gravel, wet forest and minerals.

[6] VINA ROBLES PETIT VERDOT 2012 PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA

\$30.99



Cherry and dark chocolate with hints of fine tobacco. Medium to full-bodied; cherry and cocoa powder flavors with a fine grain, chalky finish.

PREMIUM WHITE



**[1] CHATEAU DE BREZE CLOS DU MIDI SAUMUR 2014
LOIRE, FRANCE**

\$19.99

The wine shows a great, regal acidity combined with delicate, chalky texture. Clos du Midi's aromas are discrete expressions of honey, dried exotic fruits, herbal tea and sweet lemon. Although this wine is 100% Chenin Blanc, it bears the freshness of a young Sancerre, the soft richness of Chablis, but with the unmistakable charm of Chenin Blanc.



**[2] JERMANN CHARDONNAY 2013
FRIULI-VENEZIA GIULIA, ITALY**

\$32.99

Its color is brilliant straw yellow with greenish highlights, its aroma is intense and fruity with notes of banana when young, and goldendelicious apple when mature. Lightly aromatic and with excellent persistence.



**[3] JEAN-BAPTISTE ADAM LES NATURES RIESLING 2014
ALSACE, FRANCE**

\$28.99

Bright straw-green. Mint, flowers and a leesy note on the pungent nose. Then surprisingly tactile and rich on entry, but with lemony acidity lifting the herbal fruit flavors on the long, crisp back end.

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
