**|1| MENGUANTE TEMPRANILLO 2014
CARIÑENA, SPAIN**

\$13.99

Cherry, dark berry, and candied flower aromas with some pepper. Smooth and round. Cherry, sweet raspberry, and cassis flavors. Soft, supple finish. 90 Pts. Vinous



**|2| PUNTO FINAL MALBEC CLÁSICO 2015
MENDOZA, ARGENTINA**

\$12.99

Dark ruby red in color with violet tones, this Malbec has aromas of red currants, blackberries, and plums, with notes of pepper and clove. Flavors of black cherries, red and black currants, and juicy plums fill the mouth with hints of wood spice and vanilla on the finish.



**|3| DOMAINE SONOMA CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2014
SONOMA, CALIFORNIA**

\$16.99

Classic Cabernet Sauvignon produced from hand-harvested grapes picked at ideal maturity. Depth of flavor with hint of spice and pepper. Oak complexity with smooth finish.



**|4| MOULIN DE GASSAC PINOT NOIR 2015
PAYS D'OC, FRANCE**

\$15.99

The classic Pinot nose of bright candied cherries and hints of roasted fruit and moka lead into a fresh mouthwatering wine with soft tannins and a persistent finish. This wine will keep you coming back for more!



**|5| PRODIGIO NERO D'AVOLA 2015
SICILY, ITALY**

Aromas of ripe dark-skinned fruit and a whiff of exotic spice lead the nose on this straightforward red. The medium-bodied palate offers prune, mature black cherry and a hint of star anise alongside dusty, but rather fleeting tannins that leave a tongue-drying finish.



**|6| GUÍMARO RIBEIRA SACRA 2012
MENCIA, SPAIN**

This un-oaked red is all about immediate pleasure with pure, lush red fruits, spices, and slate-laden minerality. A wine to pair with all kinds of foods, especially chorizos, embutidos, roast pork, spicy foods, any dish with a lot of Pimentón.

|1| SUAVIA SOAVE CLASSICO 2014 VENETO, ITALY

\$15.99

Suavia Soave Classico appears bright and lemon-yellow. Fresh aromas of apple, pear and almond balance clean minerality and a hint of fresh herb. Crisp and refreshing on the palate, the flavors and aromas build toward a harmonious and lingering finish.



|2| ROBERT OATLEY SIGNATURE CHARDONNAY 2014 MARGARET RIVER, AUSTRALIA

\$12.99

Bright and sunny with pear, apple and white peach flavor before then raising more serious points. Said points come in the form of flint, matchstick and the grunt of grapefruit, all laced with smoky oak.



|3| ZE BECCO VERDICCHIO 2015 ABRUZZO, ITALY

\$12.99

It has a hint of anise, too. Aromatic, fleshy, dry, and savory, this type of white wine has chameleon-like qualities. Enjoy it year-round, day and night, without thinking too hard about food pairings.



|4| TORA BAY SAUVIGNON BLANC 2015 MARTINBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

\$16.99

Equally aromatic and delicious, this brims with honeysuckle, passion fruit and nectarine flavors that are generous, juicy, ripe and delicious. Shows focus and a wonderful acidity on a light body.



|5| SAINT VERNY LE PINOT NOIR 2012 VIN DE PAYS, FRANCE

\$12.99

Pale pink in color with subtle aromas of fresh strawberries and a touch of minerality and wildflowers. The wine's flavors are pristine, offering a racy acidity that cuts across an array of flavors from fruity to earthy to floral. The finish is mouth-wateringly immaculate.



|6| FAIRVIEW CAPE GRANITE BLEND 2015 PAARL, SOUTH AFRICA

\$13.99

Vibrant light green in colour, with aromas of white peach and floral notes on the nose. A medium bodied wine, with stone fruit flavours that follow through on the palate and a refreshing acidity that leads to a long finish.

[1] MAISON D'ENVOYE TAMAR VALLEY PINOT NOIR 2015

TASMANIA, AUSTRALIA

\$34.99

This is a delicate and fragrant style of Pinot with distinct characters of red apple, cranberry, nutmeg, and earth notes. The judicious use of oak works to this wine's advantage by imparting a nice mouthfeel against the generous, supple palate.



[2] CHATEAU DE FRANCS LES CERISIERS 2010

BORDEAUX, FRANCE

\$21.99

Wonderful red bordeaux showing bold aromas of blackberry, plums, crème de cassis, vanilla, spices and crushed violets. It possesses a full body, backed by round, polished tannins with intense concentration of fruit.



[3] DONKEY & GOAT THE GALLIVANTER 2015

SIERRA FOOTHILLS, CALIFORNIA

\$23.99

A blend of pinot noir, syrah, and grenache gris, this wine comes from the husband and wife team that is at the forefront of the California natural wine scene. Fruit-forward and plush, bursting with bright cherry fruit, and light on its feet, with plenty of zip and acidity.



[4] VINCA MINOR MENDOCINO BLEND N/V

MENDOCINO, CALIFORNIA

\$28.99

65% Zinfandel from Anderson Valley and 35% blend of whole cluster Carignan & Petite Sirah from Mendocino. Combination of cool blue and red berry fruit with a touch of pepper and earth.



[5] JAROS VENDIMIA SELECCIONADA TINTO RESERVA 2007

RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN

\$21.99

Deep, black cherry color. Aromas of red fruit embodied with toffee oaky hints from the aging in French barrel revealing a sweet and fruity wine on the mouth. Reminiscences of ripen fruit and liquorice. It offers a pleasant and soft aftertaste.



[6] WATERSTONE ZINFANDEL 2012

NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

\$24.99

This bold Zinfandel has great structure and finesse. Aromas of ripe currant, blackberry and cedar lead to jammy flavors of black cherry and cranberry with a hint of black pepper.

PREMIUM WHITE



[1] DOMAINE FOURNIER SANCERRE LES BELLES VIGNES 2015
LOIRE, FRANCE **\$29.99**

100% Sauvignon sourced from vines an average age of 15 to 20 years and fermented in stainless steel. A clear golden green in color, this Loire white offers well-developed fruit aromas on the nose. On the palate, full and round with flavors of berries, grapefruit and minerality and wonderful crispness. Pairs well with fish and seafood dishes.



[2] TALBOTT SLEEPY HOLLOW VINEYARD CHARDONNAY 2013
CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA **\$29.99**

Like all of Talbott wines, this Sleepy Hollow Chardonnay is made exclusively from estate-grown grapes. It has aromas of pear and green apple, complemented by French oak and toasty brioche notes. On the palate, it is lush and elegant, with a creamy mouthfeel and flavors of white peach and pear. Round oak tannins are perfectly balanced by acidity, and there is a long finish that builds over time. The Sleepy Hollow Vineyard defines this wine, with power, richness, and bright acidity.



[3] VITATGE VIELH DE LAPEYRE JURANCON SEC 2012
PYRENEES, FRANCE **\$27.99**

Dressed in pale gold, this cuvée presents light aromas of muscat, followed on airing by aromas of raisined grapes, dried fruits and brioche. The palate is supported by great freshness with sweet notes of oak making an overall elegant wine and leaving a lasting impression. It goes perfectly with fish dishes, with grilled poultry or roast veal served in a white sauce with chanterelle or morel mushrooms and with ripe cheeses.

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
