REGULAR RED



**|1| LE MAZET DE SALLELES CABERNET SAUVIGNON/SYRAH 2012
LANGUEDOC, FRANCE \$16.99**

A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah, is made from 100% estate grown grapes and reveals an intense bouquet of red fruit, spices and woody notes. Its fruity character is accompanied by a good structure, silky tannins and a long pleasant finish.



**|2| PERTINACE DOLCETTO D'ALBA 2016
PIEDMONT, ITALY \$16.99**

A splendidly fragrant, fruity dry red wine made with grapes from our Treiso and Alba vineyards. A well-structured, elegant wine with a wealth of flavour, it pairs perfectly with all dishes from Italian and international cuisine.



**|3| LAS PERDICES RED BLEND 2016
MENDOZA, ARGENTINA \$14.99**

Intense purple red color. Complex berry aromas with delicate oak touches. Soft in mouth, balanced, plum and cherry notes. Ideal to serve with red meat, pasta, fish and white meat with spiced sauces.



**|4| POGGIO AL FRASSINO GUTTURNIO 2016
EMILIA-ROMAGNA, ITALY \$12.99**

A blend of Barbera and Bonarda that could become a tradition at your dinner table. Bone dry and super fresh, with notes of wildflowers, minerals and crisp black cherry and blackberry fruit, this is the perfect wine for salumi and pizza. The estate's vines have earned "Natural Valley" certification, and are farmed using natural products.



**|5| SIMONNET FEBVRE 100 SERIES PINOT NOIR 2013
VIN DE FRANCE \$15.99**

This is a blend of grapes from Burgundy and the south of France. It is a soft, gentle wine that has red fruits and soft tannins. The acidity and wild strawberry flavors are right up front. It is ready to drink.



**|6| VILLA ANDRETTI CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2016
NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA \$10.99**

This Cabernet Sauvignon expresses notes of blackberry, cassis, plum, currant, spice, and tobacco. Pair with rich, intense meat dishes such as beef, lamb, and venison to match its opulent fruit and tannins with the dense protein of the red meat.

REGULAR WHITE



[1] SPY VALLEY RIESLING 2015
MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND **\$14.99**

Made in a convincing dry style, this medium-bodied wine starts off with hints of lime and kerosene, then adds peach kernel and citrus flavors on the smooth-textured palate.



[2] VILLA ANDRETTI CHARDONNAY 2016
NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA **\$10.99**

This refreshing Chardonnay is more like a Viognier or Pinot Gris with its aromatic floral, tropical fruit, citrus, melon and spice aromas and flavors. Still, it's very tasty, and dry as well, with a crisp spine of minerally acidity.



[3] DEALY LANE SAUVIGNON BLANC 2014
NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA **\$10.99**

Smooth and bright, this fruity Sauvignon Blanc offers vanilla and tropical coconut, with medium levels of acidity and weight. The finish revisits the sun-kissed tropical theme.



[4] PULLUS PINOT GRIGIO 2017
ŠTAJERSKA, SLOVENIA **\$16.99**

Pinot Grigio is a wine with a rosy-coopery hue in its colour, which is typical for overripe macerated grapes of this variety. Its nuances are expressed in the bouquet, which hints at ripe pears and overripe melons. The intense bouquet gives the wine a full aftertaste, which is due to the extended maceration. The creamy aftertaste which is typical of aging on lees rounds out this wine and creates a pleasant harmony of aroma and flavour.



[5] CASA DO VALLE BRANCO 2017
VINHO VERDE, PORTUGAL **\$13.99**

Produced exclusively with White grapes produced in Casa do Valle's property, this dry white wine presents a bright, pale straw color, an elegant floral, citric and tropical fruits aroma. It's a very fresh and elegant wine with a long finish.



[6] SUAVIA SOAVE CLASSICO 2014
NAHE, GERMANY **\$14.99**

Fresh aromas of apple, pear and almond balance clean minerality and a hint of fresh herb. Crisp and refreshing on the palate, the flavors and aromas build toward a harmonious and lingering finish. Ideal as an aperitif, Suavia Soave Classico matches well with a wide array of dishes, from hors d'oeuvres and fresh fish to white meats and young cheeses.

|1| MILAN NESTRAEC FORKS & KNIVES 2016 MORAVIA, CZECH REPUBLIC

\$36.99



A bright nose of cherry, raspberry and a bit of earth. The palates perfectly balanced with red berries, minerals, and nice acidity. Chalk and cherry on a clean finish. Pair with duck, roasted chicken, cheeses, salmon, or as a nice aperitif served cool. The wine is bottled unfiltered, unfinned, and with zero sulfur added.

|2| MCNAB RIDGE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2015 MENDOCINO, CALIFORNIA

\$19.99



Inviting scents of black cherries, tobacco, and a creamy vanilla with a mouth full of rich fruit and elegant, integrated oak. Good weight at entry followed by a solid center and smooth finish. Tannins are moderate which suggests the wine will cellar well for several years.

|3| LA QUERCIA MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO RISERVA 2014 ABRUZZO, ITALY

Earthy aromas and flavors of mulberry compote, dried apricot, nougat, and marinated meat and mushroom. Dry-yet-fruity and medium-length finish with fine tannins and light oak.

|4| SYLVAIN LANGOUREAU HAUTES-COTES-DE-BEAUNE 2016 BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Classic Burgundy Pinot Noir with spicy nose leads to fresh plums, cranberries, fresh herbs, mandarin rind, black tea. Medium-bodied, light tannins and a snap of acid. Enjoy now.

|5| CUVÉE TERRASSES COUJAN 2017 LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON, FRANCE

Coujan is a succulent blend of Syrah, Mourvedre, Merlot, and Grenache that's sustainably farmed and tastes best with a moderate chill. Made from 100% de-stemmed grapes to focus on the purity of the fruit, this eminently quaffable red delivers delicious ripe plum and blueberry flavors with balanced acidity and fairly low tannins.

|6| SAN SALVATORE CERASO AGLIANICO 2016 CAMPANIA, ITALY

Full-bodied and exuberant with notes of plum and sweet spices. Accompanies all dishes with strong flavours, especially medium and aged cheeses, and roasted and grilled meat.

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**|4| JEAN-MARIE CHALAND MACON-VILLAGE LES TILLES 2016
BURGUNDY, FRANCE**

\$24.99

A bright Chardonnay with nose of citrus and passion fruits. Its very expressive, round and well balanced character makes it a pleasant fresh wine for aperitif.



**|5| ENJINGI GRASEVINA 2013
SLAVONIA, CROATIA**

\$21.99

Croatia's natural winemaker shows us with this wine, much like with his dry late-harvest and aged Rhein Riesling. A classically enchanting wine - herbaceous and petrol notes, minerality, and really nice ripe and dried autumn fruit on the nose lead to a complex palate that is layered and surprisingly fresh with acidity.



**|6| COSTERS DEL PRIORAT BLANC DE PISSARRES 2015
PRIORAT, SPAIN**

\$32.99

The nose shows the marked personality of the White Grenache with its characteristic notes of white flowers, herbs and fruit skin. The palate is unctuous, with citrus and smoky flavours. The finish is very persistent and offers a surprising and lovely sweet touch. It is the warm and charming footprint of the Pedro Ximenez variety, in interesting balance with a fresh and genuine minerality.
